SUBJECT: Army Medical Department (AMEDD) Enlisted Commissioning Program
(AECF) FY 02 Information and Application Guidelines

1. The AECF allows active duty enlisted soldiers to obtain a scholarship to attend college in a full-time student status while still receiving full pay and benefits in their current grade. Upon earning their Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree and successfully completing the National Council for Licensure Examination-RN (NCLEX-RN), these soldiers are commissioned Second Lieutenants in the Army Nurse Corps (active component).
2. Application to the AECF is open to all active duty army enlisted soldiers, regardless of Military Occupational Specialty, who are able to gain acceptance as a full time student to an accredited nursing program with an academic and clinical curriculum in English; and graduate within 24 calendar months.
3. Please take the time to read through this packet carefully. It contains all the information necessary for proper application completion.
